



## Official Protocol for Riders with Prosthetic Limbs

At Storybook Land, safety of park guests and staff members is our highest priority. Storybook Land is responsible for adhering to all of the safety protocols and recommendations set forth by the ride manufacturer and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

**It is by those standards that Storybook Land respectfully requires that all guests boarding rides must be capable of grasping safety handles, lap bars, restraints, etc. to hold on to for safety.**

Extra caution on any attraction must be exercised when a guest with a prosthetic limb is on board. However, the following attractions may create a more hazardous situation for guests with prosthetic limbs and bystanders. It is for that reason Storybook Land respectfully requests that prosthetic legs that are capable of being removed must be removed for the following rides:

**Tick Tock Clock Drop**

**Beanstalk Bounce**

**Out on a Limb**

Because guests must hold on to lap bars at all times, Storybook Land does not request that prosthetic arms be removed for any attraction.

Even with the prosthetic leg removed, riders must still be able to maintain proper riding position (to grasp safety devices). If the Ride Operator and/or Park Management deem that a rider is not secure in the ride seat, Storybook Land reserves the right to dismiss the guest from that ride.
