

# Know Before You Go

## Admissions

Storybook Land is no longer required to operate at a limited capacity as per NJ Governor Murphy's recent mandate changes. However you will still have to select a date when purchasing online tickets. This is in place so we can monitor our daily numbers of guests.

Reservations are no longer required.

- Tickets purchased with a specific date are valid on that date only. If you wish to come on a different day you would need to contact us at

to request a date change and make those tickets valid for another day.

- Online tickets are discounted at \$26.95 + tax per person ages 2 and up.
- You may purchase your admission at the park entrance.

### Admission at the gate:

**General Admission \$29.95 + tax (2 to 64)**

**Senior \$26.95 + tax (65+)**

**Military/First Responder \$25.95 + tax**  
**Medical Professional**

- Military, First Responder, and Medical Professional discount tickets are available at the gate **ONLY**. They are per person in the same transaction. Must present VALID photo identification to receive discount.

## Ride Operations

- Our ride operations have returned to full capacity.
- Some ride operations may be limited and/or temporarily suspended while sanitizing procedures are carried out.

## Indoor Dining

- **Mobile Ordering** will be available for select snack bars in Storybook Land. Be sure to download the FanFood app or scan QR codes available throughout the park.

## General Health & Safety

- Touchless hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the park, inside indoor facilities, and at every ride.
- Please wash your hands often!
- Continue to be mindful of social distancing throughout your day with us.
- Keep a minimum of 6 feet between you and other guests and employees.

## Season Passholders

- **Any requests to refund or extend any unused 2020 season passes will not be accepted. (No exceptions; passes will not be extended further)**
- Passes purchased once the park opened in July 2020 were purchased at a discounted rate and are not eligible for the pass extension.
- Passholders extended through 2021 and new passholders purchased for 2021 are eligible for a 10% discount in gift shops and snack bars.
- Any unused Bring A Friend tickets remaining from 2020 expired on Dec. 30, 2020 as stated prior to starting the 2020 season. They were only made available for 2020 as compensation for lost time in 2020. They are not part of 2021 passholder benefits.
